Please use this checklist to ensure your team is properly registered for the event. If emailing your registration forms, **only PDF files will be accepted. Put the team Gender, Age in Name in the Subject line of the email.**(example: GU16 Chili Attack Team Registration) <mailto:tournaments@chilisoccer.org>. Everything MUST be contained in one email. Do not send it until you have everything attached. Email registration will be accepted through 5/28/19. If not registered by this date, you must register on site at the tournament headquarters no less than an hour before your first game.

Items	Email PDF Instructions
Official Team Roster: One copy of the official USYSA State Association or US Club Soccer approved roster. The roster must include player jersey numbers. This copy is retained at the tournament headquarters. Foreign teams must provide an equivalent roster as approved by their state, provincial, or national association.	Submit one PDF copy, and keep one copy.
Player Passes: Player passes for each participating player issued by the same organization as the official team roster. Passes will be cross-referenced with the official team roster. Passes are kept with the team representative and must be available throughout the tournament.	Submit PDF scan of all player passes. Front only is required.
Medical Releases: Your club or organization medical releases for each participating player should be with the team throughout the tournament. We require only the Team Medical Verification Release Form , stating that you have these individual releases.	Submit PDF scan of the Team Medical Release
Permission to Travel: A copy of the state (or province) association's permission to travel for teams traveling from outside their home state. Required for USYSA teams. US Club Soccer teams do not need a permission to travel.	If required, submit one PDF copy.
Guest Players: The same items listed above are required for guest players. Guest players information should be added to the bottom of the official team roster when it is submitted. A maximum of three (3) guest players are permitted per team, as long as the roster does not exceed the maximum number of players.
